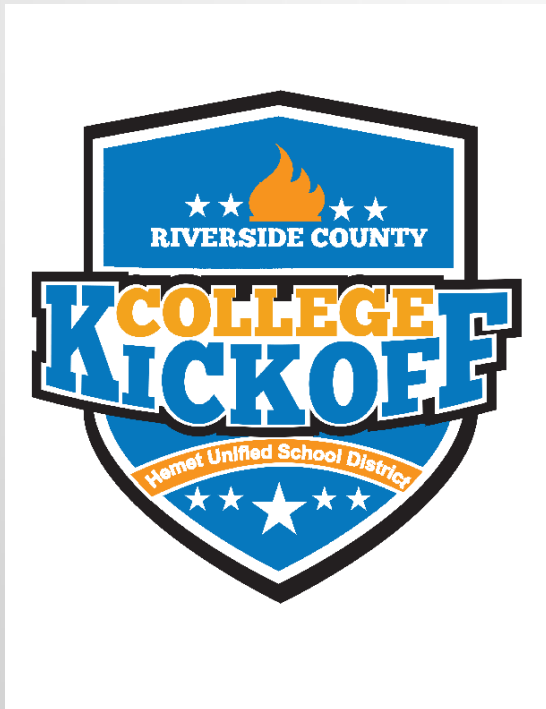

Why College?

- Two-thirds of all jobs in 2020 will require some postsecondary training (Certificate, Associate's Degree, Bachelor's Degree)
- 2017 Median Salary/Unemployment Rate* (U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics)

College Options: University of California (UC)

- Bachelor's, Master's, Doctoral, Professional Degrees (**most prestigious university system in the world**)
- Berkeley, Los Angeles, Santa Barbara, San Diego, Irvine, Davis, Riverside, Santa Cruz, Merced
- Cost of Attendance (living on campus): \$35,300 (\$13,900 fees)
- Financial Aid: Blue & Gold Opportunity Plan, Pell/Cal Grants, Work Study, Scholarships
- Admission Requirements: a-g courses/3.0 GPA SAT/ACT Application/personal insight questions
- www.admission.universityofcalifornia.edu application fee may be waived
- **(deadline: November 30)**

College Options: California State University (CSU)

- Bachelor's & Master's Degrees (46% of California Bachelor's Degrees)
- San Diego State, San Marcos, Fullerton, San Bernardino, Pomona, LA, Northridge, Dominguez Hills, Long Beach, Channel Islands, Maritime, Fresno, San Jose, San Francisco, Humboldt, Chico, Stanislaus, East Bay, SLO, Monterey Bay, Sonoma, Sacramento, Bakersfield
- Average Cost of Attendance (living on campus): \$25, 011 (**\$5742 fees**)
- Financial Aid: Pell/Cal Grants, Work Study, Scholarships
- Admission Requirements: A-G courses/**2.0 GPA** SAT/ACT Application (no personal statement)
- 2950 eligibility index (800 x GPA + SAT) or **3.0 GPA in A-G courses = guaranteed admission** to San Marcos, Dominguez Hills, Channel Islands, Maritime, Chico, Stanislaus, Bakersfield, Humboldt, SFSU
- www2.calstate.edu/apply (Google "Cal State Apply")
- application fee may be waived
- (**deadline: November 30**)

College Options: Community College

- Associate's Degrees, Vocational Certificates, **Transfer Programs**
- **112 campuses statewide**; MSJC, Palomar, RCC etc.
- Cost: \$1104 fees (not counting living expenses)
- Financial Aid: Board of Governor's Waiver, scholarships, Cal Grants
- Admission Requirements: High School Diploma and application/placement test (no a-g or SAT/ACT)
- www.msjc.edu no application fee
- ***Application deadline: mid-August, but earlier applications receive priority registration***

College Options: Private & Out of State Colleges

- All degree levels depending upon school
- USC, USD, Stanford, Cal Baptist, Point Loma, Azusa Pacific, University of Redlands, NAU, ASU, etc.
- Private Cost: \$50,407 (32,100 tuition)
- Out of State WUE: \$23,000-\$30,000
- Financial Aid: Pell/Cal Grant, Work Study, Scholarships
- Admission requirements and deadlines vary (December 1 – March 1)
application fees may be waived

SAT Test Prep/Score Reports

- Free SAT prep is available on the College Board website (www.collegeboard.org) through Khan Academy
- You will have the option on your SAT answer sheet to list up to (4) four-year colleges that you want to receive your SAT scores (community colleges do not require SAT scores). You only need to send your scores to **one UC or CSU campus** and **all** UC or CSU campuses will receive your scores.
- Log into your College Board account to get codes for other schools and bring them with you to the SAT on October 10.

FAFSA

- **All seniors should complete a FAFSA**
- IRS Data Retrieval Tool makes it even easier to apply without needing parent/student financial information.
- www.fafsa.gov
- Available beginning October 1. Submission deadline is March 2.
- Students without a SS# should complete a California Dream Act Application instead of FAFSA (www.dream.csac.ca.gov).

FSA ID

- Serves as an electronic signature and log-in credential for FAFSA and financial aid sites
- Both student and one parent should create a FSA ID
- Go to www.fafsa.gov and click on FSA ID in page banner
