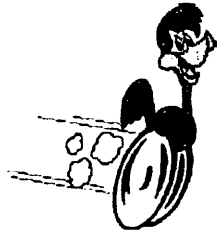

Parent & Family Engagement Policy

Reeds Elementary, along with Davidson County Schools will follow this policy to involve parents in developing a district parent and family engagement plan:

Parent/Community Engagement Committee:

Instructional Assistants, Teachers, Lead Teacher, and Administrators will work together to create upcoming Title 1 Events. The goal is host events allowing students and families to share exciting parts of instruction taking place here at Reeds. We hope to encourage high attendance rates for these events.
