#### DCCC Career and College Promise/OGHS Welding Program

The OGHS Welding Program is a part of the CCP Program offered through DCCC. To be eligible for enrollment, high school freshmen must meet the following criteria:

- Pass Math 1 with a grade of 'C' or better
- Score a 3, 4, or 5 on the EOC for Math 1
- Score a 3, 4, or 5 on the 8<sup>th</sup> grade End of Grade ELA Assessment
- *Any student who does not meet any of the above criteria may still qualify for this program through DCCC placement/college-readiness testing (this will be administered at OGMS)*

In order to be eligible to register for Honors and/or Advanced Placement (AP) courses, a student must have achieved the following course averages in the pre-requisite Core course that was taken in the 2018-19 school year:

- Honors – 85 or above (ex. to be eligible for English 2 Honors, a student must have earned an 85 or above in English 1 Honors).
- Regular – 90 or above (ex. to be eligible for English 2 Honors, a student must have earned a 90 or above in English 1).
