# PURPOSE STATEMENT

**Community Christian School is designed to:**

## **Mission Statement**

- ▶ Educate the students in the following biblical truths:
  1. The Bible is the only inspired Word of God and is the inerrant and final authority in faith and life for the believer.
  2. God is real as Creator and Provider and that He exists in three personalities Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
  3. Jesus Christ:
    - Is the Son of God.
    - Was Born of the virgin, Mary.
    - Was crucified, buried and raised from the dead.

  4. Man:
    - Is a sinner by nature and choice.
    - Is separated from God apart from personal faith in the Gospel of Jesus Christ for salvation.
  5. Repentance is commanded by God and necessary for forgiveness of sin.
  6. The Holy Spirit indwells every believer and instructs, corrects and guides him/her in all truth in his/her Christian life.
  7. Salvation is by grace through faith in Jesus Christ and not as a part of any works nor merit of our own. Only the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ are able to satisfy God's righteousness for our salvation.

  - Teaches students to respect one another, their parents, the laws of our nation and those who govern.
  - Encourages each person to pursue his/her dreams and gives direction as to how to achieve them with success.

# Parent-Student Statement of Agreement and Cooperation

After reading Community Christian School's Purpose Statement, we ask that you prayerfully consider and complete the portion below:

## Statement of Agreement and Cooperation

As a family, we have carefully read and discussed the CCS Statement of Purpose. Being in full agreement with each we:

1. Accept the responsibility for instructing and motivating our child to: cheerfully obey the school rules; respect those in authority; respect school property; complete all daily assignments and course requirements; and faithfully attend all classes.
2. Sincerely pledge our loyalty and support by presenting all questions and criticisms regarding policy or application of policy, directly to the administration, in a scriptural manner, for proper explanation, consideration or appeal.
3. Recognize the importance of our testimonies before the world and therefore endeavor to avoid even the appearance of evil. We will seek to be distinctively different, providing a climate for spiritual growth in our home. We actively support CCS by directing and teaching our children not to use coarse or obscene language; sow seed of discord among the student body or school family; use any harmful substance including tobacco, alcohol or drugs; to refrain from sexual misconduct; attend or participate in activities which dull the spiritual senses.
4. Hereby agree to abide strictly by the rules and regulations as adopted by the governing authority of CCS, understanding that the teacher and administration have full discretion in the discipline of our child according to the Bible. We give permission for the teacher and/or other agent of the school to make and enforce classroom rules in a manner consistent with Christian principles and discipline as set forth in the Scriptures. When all methods of discipline fail, or the offense merits it, corporal punishment may be administered by the parents at school.
5. Recognize that the teacher and administration have full discretion as to the grade placement of our child.
6. Give our child permission to take part in all school activities including sports and field trips and will not hold the school liable to us or our child because of injury to our child at school or during any school activity.
7. Understand that our participation is needed in lending practical help and support both academically and spiritually in a mutual effort to train our children. Because of this, we will endeavor to attend parent-teacher conferences and school meetings unless providentially hindered.
8. Agree to pick up our child by 3: 15 PM each day or the child will be enrolled in the after school care program regardless of age.
9. Understand the school financial policy and will keep our account current at all times, knowing that the testimony of the Lord, the school and our family are all at stake in the event that bills are not paid on time. In the event of withdrawal or dismissal, I am required to pay a \$500 withdrawal fee.
10. Believe and understand the importance of a Christian education for our child and recognize the Satanic warfare waged against those seeking to follow God and His Word. Therefore, we regularly attend a Bible-believing church and strive to put those Christian principles learned into practice in our home.
11. When difficult issues arise, CCS, parents and students will follow the Biblical example of arbitration to reach amicable conclusions.

Therefore, in prayerful consideration of our preceding agreements, we willingly accept and support the policies and principles upon which CCS is founded.
