

6th Grade M-Step Testing Information

May 2, 2018

The **M-STEP: Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress** is scheduled to begin next week for the 6th graders on Tuesday, May 8th at Meads Mill. It is important that students arrive promptly on the scheduled dates of testing. We encourage students to be well rested for testing and eat a healthy breakfast before arriving to school on the morning of the test. The testing dates for 6th grade students at Meads Mill are below:

Tuesday, May 8 (am)	Math Computer Adaptive Test
Wednesday, May 9 (am)	ELA Computer Adaptive Test (<i>earbuds</i>)

We are requesting that students bring:

- His/her own **earbuds or headphones** on the day of the ELA testing (5/9), as they are needed to complete the test. (*Disposable earbuds will be provided for students who do not have them.*)
- **Writing Utensil** (pen or pencil) to each day of testing
- **Free reading book** when a student has completed his/her test

Students may NOT bring:

- Cell phones may not enter the testing location under any circumstance
- Textbooks to the testing location
- Homework or notebooks/paper to the testing location
- Food (including gum and candy/mints) and drink are not permitted in the testing rooms.
