Things to do before Transition Day, August 23, 2019

Transition day is Friday, August 23, 2019.

**Annual Online Registration Documents & Digital Signatures- Required for schedule pick up!
To access the Annual Registration in Parent Connection, you must use either a desktop or laptop computer, as it is not compatible with cell phones or tablets at this time.**

Every year all families are required to fill out the digital Annual Registration for each student. This year families can complete these forms starting on Thursday, August 15, 2019 through Parent Connection. Through this process you will be asked to update your student's emergency contact information, home address and health information, review our technology use policy and student handbooks, learn more about PTA and access the website and much more.

All Meads Mill students must have the Annual Registration completed before Transition Day on August 23, 2019 in order for their student to receive their schedule and locker assignment.

6th Grade:

7th Grade:

A-K 10:00 am

L-Z 10:30 am

8th Grade:

A-K 8:00 am

L-Z 8:45 am

If you are unable to make it to transition day, the Meads Mill office will be open August 26 - 29th, 8-3:30 pm to drop off any forms and pick up students schedule.

The following days are available for you to come in with your student(s) if you need to walk their schedule or set up their locker.

Monday, August 26: 8am-3pm

Wednesday, August 28: 8am-3pm

The Meads Mill Office is open M-F from 7:30-3:30 but will be closed on August 30 and September 2.

Transition day picture make up is September 10th.

Items to bring to Transition Day

- Outstanding book fines or overdue books must be paid or turned in to the Meads Mill office
- Individual Emergency Health Care Plans (if applicable mailed out in June 2019)
- Medications
- MHSAA Physicals if student is planning to play a sport. Must be completely filled out and signed by doctor, parent and student.
- I-Chat volunteer form (requires copy of driver's license to accompany for processing)
- Immunization Records (7th grade only if applicable)
- Residency Information (if applicable) to the Meads Mill Office
- Material Donation form for 6/7 grade classroom magazines

Fines & Residency Proofs

If you received a notice / letter indicating your student owes a book or a fine, or if you have updated residency information to provide, please try to resolve that matter in the main office prior to Transition Day. If you will be bringing in paperwork on Transition Day, your student's schedule will be available in the office.

Medication Drop Off

The school office is now open to accept medications, doctor forms, and Health Care/Asthma Plans for the 2019-20 school year. These should be turned in prior to the start of the school year to ensure that we have everything in place for students on the first day of school. All medications (including over-the-counter) must have physician authorization. Medications must be in their original container and must be current.

Immunization Information

All students that are new to the district and all 7th grade students at Meads Mill must have an updated immunization record OR an immunization waiver from the county Health Department BEFORE the start of school. Letters were sent out to those individual students whose immunizations are not current. **Your child WILL NOT be able to start school if immunizations are not current and up to date.** The schools are no longer permitted to distribute waiver forms and can only accept those from the county Health Department. Contact your child's medical provider to arrange for any needed immunizations or your local Health Department to schedule an appointment to obtain the waiver.
