

STUDENT ACCESS TO ADVANCED PLACEMENT CLASSES

The Governing Board maintains Advanced Placement classes in certain academic subjects for students who are preparing for college. Such classes are significantly more challenging and more academically rigorous than non-advanced classes. Thus, parents and students should have a clear perception and understanding of the nature and difficulty of such classes before the student enrolls.

Every student shall have access to Advanced Placement classes but only with full knowledge and written approval of parents/guardians.

The teacher is encouraged to make a decision about the student's ability early in the semester in case a transfer or other additional support instruction is recommended. Transfers to other classes should be considered only during the first four weeks of the school year or between semesters. That decision should be made in consultation with the parent/guardian and the student with the assistance of the counselor and teacher. The parent/guardian shall make the final decision.
