-ELKS Scholarship. Deadline Jan. 15, 2019. Open to All.

-Saint Anne's Credit Union Scholarship has been extended to January 25, 2019.

-Henry David Thoreau Scholar. Deadline Feb 1, 2019. Must be majoring in Environmental Studies.

-Order Sons of Italy. Open to All. Deadline Feb 1, 2019.

-Manton Scholars Program. Open to students living in Westport. Applicant's family must have been significantly and negatively affected by the death or serious illness/incapacitation of a primary income earners or the serious illness of an immediate family member (parent/primary care giver or sibling). FAFSA must be completed. Examples of serious illness/incapacitation is cancer, stroke, brain injury, severe mental illness. Exclusions include: chronic conditions such as diabetes or asthma, developmental disabilities such as autism or substance abuse. Deadline is Feb 1, 2019

-Red Pine Scholarship. Available to low to middle income families, strong academic record or have shown significant improvement over time and planning to enroll as a freshman at a competitive 4 year college. Deadline Feb 15, 2019.

-Yawkey Scholars Program. Available to students with a strong academic record or have demonstrated a significant improvement over time, planning on attending a competitive private college in Massachusetts, engaged in a significant mentoring or leadership role and have unmet financial need and would benefit from the scholarship. Deadline is Feb 14, 2019.

-2019 National Interscholastic Athletic Administrators Association Scholar/Essay Scholarship: Open to seniors who have a B+ average, ranked in the top 25% of their class, have an ACT score of 24 or higher or a SAT score of 1100, must have participated in two sports, must have one varsity letter. Deadline Feb 28, 2019.

- Community Foundation of Southeastern Massachusetts-Several scholarships available through one application. Open to all Deadline March 1, 2019.**
- Rockland Trust Scholarship. Open to all except Rockland Trust members. Deadline is March 11, 2019**
- The Rebekah Assembly of Massachusetts of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows Scholarship. Open to All. Deadline March 15, 2019.**
- Mark Bavis Leadership Foundation Scholarship. Open to all but a focus is on leadership. Deadline March 15, 2019.**
- The Susana Viera Multiple Sclerosis Foundation Scholarship. Available to seniors majoring in Engineering, Computer Science, Medical/Nursing, or the Social Services Field. Deadline is March 16, 2019**
- South coast Health-The Auxiliary of Charlton Memorial Hospital. Open to all students majoring in careers in the medical field. Deadline April 1, 2019.**
