<p>Have a pajama party while reading a Good Fit book with an adult. Read the book with a friend or sibling in your pajamas while eating popcorn (or whatever food your parent suggests.)</p>	<p>Go to the public library, get your own library card, (if you don't have one), check out a book -- and read it! (And return the book when you're finished!)</p>	<p>Draw a picture of something that is special to you. A place, an activity, a special person. Ask an adult to help label the picture</p>
<p>Draw a picture and ask an adult to help you write a short story to go with it.</p> <p>Use your imagination!</p>	<p>Read a Good Fit nonfiction book with an adult.</p> <p>Draw a picture about the subject. Ask a parent to help you label the picture.</p>	<p>Read a Good Fit book that has an animal character to your favorite stuffed animal.</p>
