



Tom Landry Stadium Guidelines



Home Fans, Visitors, Head Coaches and Administrators:

Mission CISD would like to welcome everyone to our stadium. As we enter this year's football season, we want to assure all our fans and visitors that we will host a safe environment for our participating students, staff members, and including all fans. The following guidelines are in order to keep our stadium clean and safe. We expect that all will adhere to the guidelines as followed:

1. Fan and Student Guidelines:

- a. Security Staff will be using metal detectors at all entrances randomly thru out the season.
- b. **NO** backpacks allowed. ALL bags, including purses and fanny packs, will be searched.
- c. **NO** outside food or drinks when concession stands are held.
- d. **NO** types of balls (footballs, basketballs, tennis balls, etc.) of any size will be allowed to come thru the gates.
- e. Positive sportsmanship expected at ALL times. If fail to comply with rules and guidelines, will be escorted out of stadium without a ticket refund.
- f. All fans attending school sponsored events may **NOT** enter the game without their shirts on and may **NOT** take shirts off during the game or function.
- g. Everyone, a year and older, is required to have a ticket. Only high school students are allowed to sit in their designated section with a student ticket and ID.
- h. Umbrellas may be used as long as they do not obstruct the view of surrounding spectators.

2. Fundraising

- a. Inside stadium sales are exclusive to high school organizations and designated Athletic Boosters, Band Boosters, Cheer Boosters, Dance Boosters, and ROTC.
- b. Outside food and drinks will **NOT** be allowed in stadium when concession stands are held.
- c. ALL fundraising activities within stadium premises must have campus Principal and Athletic Department approval.

3. Signs / Banners

- a. Only signs or banners approved by Campus Administrators or Athletic Dept. will be allowed and must be removed immediately after the game.
- b. Signs may not obstruct the view of the spectators.
- c. Individual player signs may be hand held, but may not be displayed at the stadium.
- d. Spirit crews and hand held flags will be allowed to participate during the game with campus approval.

4. Only authorized personnel will be allowed on the sidelines

- a. Head Coach is in charge of all coaches, players, and managers in their team area.
- b. Athletic trainers are in charge of their student athletic trainers.
- c. Cheerleaders in uniform and Cheer Sponsors are allowed on the track.
- d. Mission CISD Administrators will be allowed on the track with proper ID.
- e. Inflatable tunnels are welcomed at Tom Landry Stadium and personnel will be allowed on the endline to set up prior to the start of the game and halftime, but during the game they must return to the stands. We will let you know where to place the inflatable tunnel.
- f. Students, parents, and private photographers will not be allowed on the sidelines.
- g. News Media with credentials, school photographers and special assignment personnel are permitted with proper identification / sideline pass. Everyone must abide and stand in specified UIL designated areas.

- h. Visiting TV or Radio Stations must contact MCISD Athletic Director, prior to game for location of equipment.
- i. The Athletic Department and Police/ Security Personnel along with campus game Administrators are responsible for enforcing all stadium guidelines.

5. Guidelines for the Track and Turf :

- a. **NO** balloons, confetti , streamers, silly string, glitter, rice, or powder of any kind
- b. **NO** gum or candy of any kind
- c. **NO** sunflower seeds or shelled nuts of any kind (anywhere in stadium)
- d. **NO** food of any kind
- e. **NO** sports or soft drinks of any kind (**water is only allowed**)
- f. **NO** tobacco /tobacco products (anywhere on school property)
- g. **NO** Noise makers; whistles, air horns, etc.
- h. **NO** bicycles or skateboards
- i. **NO** sharp or pointed objects/props of any kind are permitted on field unless heavy protection covers are provided.
- j. **NO** shoes with pointed heels of any kind
- k. **NO** glass containers (anywhere in stadium)
- l. **As per UIL regulations, NO** spectators are allowed onto the track or field before, during, or after any game. Special events such as parent's night must be cleared through the AD's office prior to date.
- m. **NO** vehicles are allowed on track or field without the permission from the AD.
- n. **NO** tickets will be refundable or transferable.
- o. **NO** animals allowed in stadium with the exceptions of a Seeing Eye Dog or a Canine Officer.

6. Equipment

- a. All equipment brought into the stadium needs to be rubber-based or rubber tipped.
- b. Sharp edges that may cause damage to the artificial turf shall not be allowed.
- c. Items in question to be used at games or during half time performances must have prior Athletic Department approval.

7. Guidelines for elevator use:

- a. Elevator will be used only by Administrative Personnel and individuals with prior approval: home coaches, visiting coaches, scoreboard team, announcer, time keepers, board members, individuals with elevator pass.
- b. An Elevator Pass may be issued thru the Athletic Office to an individual who:
 - 1. Shows proof of mobility disability (Texas DMV issued Parking Placard /or License Plate),
 - 2. Must sit in top ten rows,
 - 3. Understands that in case of emergency the elevator will be shut down, patron must go down stairs to exit the stadium.
 - 4. Access is limited to eligible person plus one other person to assist the eligible person.
 - 5. Must bring Driver's License or Texas ID to Athletic Office to produce Elevator Pass.
 - 6. Understand that access to the elevator may be revoked at any time at the discretion of the District.
- c. Officers will be monitoring elevator access.

- 8. A coach from the visiting school must call, and let us know what time they'll arrive. **Parking will be on the south side of the stadium.** There will be a stadium worker ready to show them to the dressing room.
 - a. Keep dressing room clean at all times.
 - b. Halftime: Home and visiting teams must allow the band to finish performing before coming on the field. **DO NOT GET ON THE PLAYING FIELD.** Teams may warm up in the end zone and behind the goal posts.

ANYONE NOT ABIDING BY THESE RULES WILL BE SUBJECTED TO BEING REMOVED FROM TOM LANDRY STADIUM.

Stadium Guidelines and Procedures

Admission to Press Box

- Home Team Football Staff (coaches working and approved personnel)
- Visiting Team Football Staff (coaches working)
- Filming Crew (upstairs)
- Home & Visitor Half Time Band Announcers
- Press Box Game Workers on Duty
- Media Personnel – with Proper Identification and Scheduling
- Accommodations may be made by Athletic Dept. during inclement weather (Home Film Crew 1st Priority)
- Scouts (Due to limited seating in press box, scouts may sit on top row on Home Side)

Entry to Stadium

- **Gates open one hour prior to game time.**
- Home football teams, athletic trainers, student trainers, coaching staff, cheerleaders, drill team, band, and band equipment trucks (through south side main gate)
- Visitor football team, athletic trainers, student trainers, coaching staff, cheerleaders, and drill teams (through northeast gate off of Bicentennial)
- Visitor band and band equipment trucks (through south side main gate)
- MISD Sub-Varsity Athletes (on pass list may enter through band hall gate)
- Officials (will drive in through south side main entry)
- Home Cheerleaders and Drill teams with Sponsors and in Uniform (Home south side gate)
- Pass List Guests (enter through south side main entry)
- MISD Athletic Coordinators & all coaches (Band hall gate or main ticket entries with 30-6A UIL pass)
- Band Boosters (enter through band hall gate/must be on pass list)
- Run Through Tunnel Personnel (enter through south side main entry)
- Present and Former MISD School Board Members (enter through south side main entry/may park in designated area)
- Media & Sportscasters (enter through south side main entry/ must present media identification). Only one vehicle will be allowed in restricted area for “live broadcast” vehicles.
- Parents during Parent’s Night (enter through band hall gate & main ticket entries/ticket required for entry)
- Homecoming Court, Class Representatives, or Volunteers assisting (must be on a pass list and may enter through band hall gate)
- Class Reunions (must purchase a ticket/may enter through main ticket entries)
- Please refer to McAllen ISD Police Department Safety Plan in regards to vehicular traffic inside stadium.
- **Backpacks and duffle bags will not be permitted in stadium facility for Varsity Football Games.**
- **All items are subject to be checked prior to entry to the stadium.**

Sidelines/Team Area

- The head coach is in charge of all coaches, players, ball boys, and team managers in their team area.
- Athletic trainers are in charge of their student athletic trainers.
- Individuals without a sideline pass must remain in the stands at all times. No unauthorized children will be allowed on the sideline, field, or track area during pre-game or game.
- Media may **not** be inside team and coaches' area.
- Middle School Football Coaches wearing their school coaching shirt will be allowed on their team sideline when their vertical team high school is playing.
- Only water is allowed on track and field areas.
- **All media must have clearance and be approved for coverage on the sidelines for Varsity Football games.**
- The Athletic Department and Police Personnel along with campus game administrators are responsible for enforcing all stadium guidelines.

Signs/Banners

- Only non-paper banners or signs approved by the campus and Athletic Department will be allowed and must be removed immediately after the game.
- All banners must be tied to the stadium railing. The taping of any signs will not be permitted.
- Paper signs will **not** be allowed to be displayed on stadium property or breezeway.
- Signs may **not** obstruct the view of spectators.
- Individual player signs may be hand held, but may not be displayed at stadium.
- Spirit crews with hand held flags will be allowed to participate during the game (with campus approval).

Student and Fan Conduct

- Students are to be reminded that they are at a school function and representing their school. All students must comply with the MISD code of conduct.
- All students and fans attending school sponsored events may **not** enter the game without their shirts on and may **not** take shirts off during the game or function.
- Positive sportsmanship is expected from all students, fans, and spectators. Anyone failing to comply with any rules and guidelines will be escorted out of the stadium.
- All spectators and fans must sit in stands – no soliciting will be allowed in the breezeway or walkways.

Fundraising

- Inside stadium sales are exclusive to high school designated athletic boosters, band boosters, cheer boosters, dance boosters, and ROTC.
- Food and drink items may **not** be sold by any school group or others when concession stands are available. Outside food and drinks will **not** be allowed in stadium when concession stands are held.
- All fundraising activities within stadium premises must have campus and Athletic Department approval.

Field and Track Guidelines

- The following items are **not** allowed on field or track: tobacco, tobacco products, gum, sun flower seeds, shelled nuts, confetti, silly string, spiked heeled shoes, lighters, candles, luminaries, bicycles, skateboards, and balloons.
- Throwing baby powder, **confetti**, glitter, silly string, or other similar items will **not** be allowed.
- Tobacco, tobacco products and alcohol are **not** allowed anywhere on school property.
- Strollers are only allowed on bottom row of stadium seating area.
- Animals are **not** allowed in the stadium area with the exceptions of a Seeing Eye Dog or a Canine Officer.
- Only water is allowed on the turf field and track.
- No glass bottles, cans, or food are allowed on the turf, track, or stadium area.
- As per UIL regulations, no fans or spectators are allowed on the field before, during, or after a contest.
- There will be no crossing over by spectators from the home side to the visitor side or vice versa.

- MISD reserves the right to limit noisemakers. No whistles or mechanical air horns will be allowed. Any homemade noisemakers which may be used as projectiles will **not** be allowed. Musical instruments shall only be used by participating bands.
- Students leaving the stadium during a game and planning to return must be forewarned that their departure will be monitored and re-entry may be denied without purchase of another ticket.
- Tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Only the home team will be allowed to use speaker systems.
- Number of students representing a group on sideline or track will be limited due to safety reasons.

Vehicles/Emergency Access

- Vehicular access to the track and field is prohibited to all vehicles except approved MISD gators and golf carts. Turf friendly tires are recommended. No vehicles may park on track at any time.
- No heavy loads will be allowed on the track or turf.
- Exceptions must be approved and cleared by the MISD Athletic Director and MISD Police Department.

Equipment

- All equipment brought into the stadium needs to be rubber-based or rubber tipped.
- Sharp edges which may cause damage to the artificial turf shall **not** be allowed.
- Items in question to be used at games or during half time performances must have prior Athletic Department approval.
