FAQs

Why is the NDB Annual Fund important?

Tuition alone doesn't cover the cost of an NDB education. Like other independent schools, NDB relies on gifts from the community to help close the gap between tuition income and expenses. For 2018–19, the gap is \$2,500 per student, and a gift to the Annual Fund helps bridge that gap.

Here are some specific examples of how your gift will be used — the latest technology and hardware, the best teaching tools and classroom equipment, athletic and arts programs, safety and security for the campus, maintenance and upkeep, and financial assistance.

Why not have tuition cover the total cost of an NDB education?

NDB is committed to keeping tuition as low as possible so more families can afford a wonderful NDB education for their daughters. Also, donations to NDB are tax-deductible, so when you give to the Annual Fund you're making a difference, helping keep tuition payments lower, and earning a tax benefit.

How much am I expected to give?

We hope that every family will be as generous as possible. Gifts of all sizes are needed and welcome. We have families who have the capacity to give beyond the \$2,500 gap and others who give as best they can. Every dollar makes a difference, and every student benefits.

What if I want to make a gift to the Annual Fund but can't give at this time?

You can pledge now and defer payment until later, or you can pay in installments, whatever is more convenient for you. All pledge payments must be received by June 30, 2019.

Do matching gifts count?

Yes. When you make a gift to NDB, you can double or triple its impact by checking with your employer to see if they participate in a matching gift program.
