BP 3511.1

**INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT**

The Governing Board believes that the conservation of water, energy and other natural resources as well as the protection of the environment is essential to the health and well-being of the community. The Superintendent or designee shall participate in integrated waste management programs to reduce waste, conserve natural resources and protect the environment.

Such programs may include specific strategies designed to help the district reduce waste generation and improve efficiency in using natural resources in all areas of its operations.

The Superintendent or designee may collaborate with city, county and state agencies in developing and implementing the district's integrated waste management program.

The Superintendent or designee may seek funding opportunities for the district's participation in integrated waste management programs including applying for available grants or other cost-reducing incentives.

The Superintendent or designee shall provide appropriate training opportunities to students and staff regarding the benefits and methods of conserving natural resources and protecting the environment.
