Registration Fee	\$750.00 If paid prior to April 20, 2019 for returning students And March 9, 2019 for incoming freshman students \$1,000.00 If paid after April 20, 2019
Capital Campaign	\$125.00 Reserved for Inspiration Building/New Performing Art Building
Fundraising Per Student	\$360.00 - \$300 Fiesta Tickets and \$60 Casino Night Both fees will be included in your Facts account
Scrip (fundraising)	Any family receiving more than \$2000 in Tuition assistance has to participate in Scrip program by purchasing \$1500.00 worth of gift cards during the school year. You also have an option to buy out of program.
Service Hours	Any family receiving financial assistance is obligated to do volunteer hours. You can donate goods or buy out your hours. Number of hours will be determined after we finalize your financial aid amount.
Financial Aid Fee	\$50 to be accompanied with your application
Facts Fee	\$45 Facts Management Company processes our tuition payments. They charge an annual fee of \$45 for their service
Late Payment Fee	\$30 for each late payment
Returned Check Fee	\$35

Payment Plans ---- We have several payment plan options starting with a selection of single payment to 11 monthly payments.

Deposits --- All registration fees are non-refundable. The tuition assistance application fee is \$50.00 and will be added to your facts account if not paid in advance.

Tuition Assistance --- TA is available for all qualifying new and re-enrolling families. All interested families must complete the application process in its entirety by the deadlines.
