Do I leave my student at the Gym on Wednesday morning??

Yes, please drop them off in front of the gym and pick up in the same location- we will take it from there. Parents, they are in good hands!

What are the start and end times for Wednesday-Friday?

The Link Crew program is from 8am-noon each day. Students should wear their Class of 2023 free t-shirt on Friday! Students need to stay the full 4 hours each day to fulfil their graduation requirements

How can I locate my student during the program in case of emergency?

We ask that parents go to the main office NOT the gym. Our office staff will be able to get in touch with us and we will walk your student to the office.

Will my student need to bring anything with them?

Students may not bring backpacks, purses or other items as the days are quite active. There is NO need for any technology items during these days.
