Casey Burkhart, Principal of Burnet High School, has been selected to represent the Texas Association of Secondary School Principals (TASSP) as the Region 13 Outstanding High School Principal of the Year. TASSP recognizes outstanding principals and assistant principals from the twenty region Education Service Centers in the state. School administrators are nominated and chosen by their peers within their regions. Nominations are based upon exemplary performance and outstanding leadership. - ✓ Approved the YMCA of the Highland Lakes as the enrichment program vendor for the BCISD after school program.
- ✓ Approved the Resolution identifying hazardous traffic conditions within 2 miles of the school campuses as presented.



The unofficial election results indicate that the August 25th Burnet CISD Tax Ratification Election (TRE) was approved by voters with 722 votes for and 74 votes against. The official results will be canvassed by the Board of Trustees on September 4th.
