What Is Title I?

Title I is a federal funding source that provides additional funding for schools with high percentages of children from low-income families to help ensure that ALL children meet challenging state academic standards.

The requirements of Title I include:

- Annual Meeting informing parents of Title I and their rights
- Title I funds used for ALL students (Schoolwide Program) to meet state academic standards
- Establish Student / Parent Compact and distribute Parent Involvement Policy
- Schools MUST involve parents in determining how funds are spent (School Site Council)
- Schools MUST participate in State and Federal Accountability programs
- Inform Parents of Academic Programs and Student Achievement Results

What does Title I provide for the Wasco Union High School District?

- Additional academic support classes for English and Mathematics
- After-school and Summer School programs to assist struggling students
- Job embedded training and staff development for teachers
- Extra instructional materials, academic supports and interventions
