



When to Keep Your Child Home

- Please keep an obviously sick child at home.
- Do not send a student to school with a **temperature over 100** degrees F.
- Remember, if you reduce your student's fever with medication like Tylenol, your student is STILL ill. Please do not medicate your student and send them to school.
- Do not send a student to school that has been **vomiting** or has had **diarrhea** within the last 12 hours.
- Do not send a student with **contagious** rash, lice, or infectious illness.
- If your child is ill in the morning, please do not bring them in later in the day. They will be allowed to make up missed work/test(s) when they return to school. Please call the Attendance office daily to excuse your child from school at 719-995-4675, ext. 465.
- When your child is out for 3 days or more due to illness they will need to bring in a note to excuse their extended absence.
- Do not send your child back to school until he/she has had **no symptoms for at least 24 hours.**
