

School District 4 plans kindergarten registration

Addison School District 4 is holding its 2018-2019 kindergarten registration for children who will be five years old on or before Sept. 1, 2018. Registration for all Addison School District 4 Kindergarten will be held at Army Trail School, 346 Army Trail Blvd., on Friday, March 9, 8-11am and noon-3pm; Thursday, March 22, 4-7pm; and Wednesday, April 4, 4-7pm.

Parents are encouraged to pick up a registration packet in advance so they will have time to gather all necessary documents and complete the required paperwork before coming to register their child. Registration packets are available at the District Office, 222 N. Kennedy Drive (Door 18), at each of the school offices, or at asd4.org. Parents must register in person.

All kindergarten classes in ASD4 are full-day classes.

For those from dual-language households

Students whose primary language is not English will be screened when they come to register in order to de-

termine class placement.

A two-way dual language program will be available to students in the Stone and Wesley School attendance areas. This program is for children whose primary language is English and who want dual-language instruction (English and Spanish) through fifth grade and for Stone and Wesley attendance area children whose primary language is Spanish. All students interested in the two-way dual language program will have the ability to sign up for the program at registration.
