Dear families,

In order to promote cooperative learning and maintain a classroom that centers around learning respect for one's self and others, the primary grades (PK - 2) classrooms will be using community supplies for some items. Other items will be managed and distributed by the teacher. Please understand that your child may need you to purchase more than one set of pencils and crayons so that they may have a set to keep at home for homework.

The following items will be shared by the class and do not need to be labeled:

- 1 composition book (black & white) **1st and 2nd grade only.**

This is a quarterly list. Some items will need to be purchased each quarter.

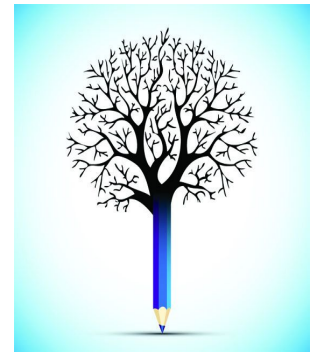
