Introduction

Each school district, education service district, and public charter school must develop a Healthy and Safe Schools Plan for all buildings owned or leased by the school district or public charter school where students and staff are present on a regular basis.

School districts, education service districts, and public charter schools must submit a preliminary draft of the Healthy and Safe Schools Plan to the Department of Education on or before October 1, 2016. School districts, education service districts, and public charter schools must submit the final draft of the Healthy and Safe Schools Plan to the Department of Education on or before January 1, 2017. Thereafter, school districts, education service districts, and public charter schools must annually submit an updated Healthy and Safe Schools Plan if new buildings are acquired, constructed, or leased or if the plan is modified by the school district, education service district, or public charter school. Plans should be submitted to the Department of Education at ode.schoolfacilities@ode.state.or.us.

Sections 1-7 of this plan set forth the required elements of a Healthy and Safe Schools. The final section of this plan, section 8, is not required. Section 8 allows districts, education service districts, and public charter schools to include additional elements that are not required but may be important to that particular community.

3. Radon

Arthur Academy has developed a radon plan as required by ORS 332.167.

1. Radon testing will be conducted in frequently occupied rooms in contact with the ground or located above a basement or a crawlspace.
2. Radon testing will be conducted at least once every 10 years beginning in 2016.
3. Arthur Academy will make all test results available to the public within five business days of receiving the results;
 - Arthur Academy will provide results to the school district and
 - Arthur Academy will make the results available to the public by posting the results on Arthur Academy website, sending notice of the results over the email system, and making the results available in hardcopy at the main administration office; and
 - Arthur Academy will provide detailed information explaining the test results.
4. Information provided will include the level of radon at which the United States Environmental Protection Agency recommends schools take action to reduce indoor radon concentrations.

4. Lead in Drinking water

1. Arthur Academy will use OHA-accredited drinking water laboratory to test and analyze all taps used for drinking and food preparation in each building. This will be done at least once every 5 years.
2. Arthur Academy will prevent access to water taps that have more than 20 parts per billion of lead. This will include shutting off of taps, covering water fountains and providing bottled water to student and staff members.

3. Arthur Academy will replace plumbing as specified by test results.

5. Lead Paint

In order to comply with the United States Environmental Protection Agency's Renovation, Repair and Painting Program Rule, Arthur Academy will only contract with certified lead based paint renovation contractors licensed by the Oregon Construction Contractors Board.

6. Integrated Pest Management

Arthur Academy has adopted an integrated pest management plan as required by ORS 634.700 through 634.750. Community members can access a copy of the IPM plan at www.arthuracademy.org.

7. Communication

1. Arthur Academy will make all test results available to the public within five business days of receiving the results;
2. Arthur Academy will make the results available to the public by posting the results on Arthur Academy website, sending notice of the results over the email system, and making the results available in hardcopy at the main administration office; and
3. Arthur Academy will provide detailed information explaining the test results.
