**RE: PARKING REGULATIONS ON NORWIN CAMPUS
No Parking along Norwin Knights Stadium Because of Public Safety Concerns**

August 9, 2018

Dear Norwin School District Parents, Guardians, Students, and Community:

Due to public safety concerns, Norwin School District Administration and the North Huntingdon Township Police Department are enforcing a "No Parking Zone" along the road next to the Norwin Knights Stadium and along all sides of Norwin High School.

In recent weeks, cars have been parked on both sides of the stadium drive during after school and evening events. This has created public safety concerns that the narrow road would not be able to accommodate emergency vehicles when clogged with parked cars. Also, please refrain from taking handicapped parking spaces unless you are authorized to do so.

Parents, students, and community members are asked not to park anywhere there is a yellow curb on District property, whether there is signage or not. Parents or community members attending after school or evening events at Norwin High School may park in the main lot or gym parking lot, which is a short walk from the stadium.

As a reminder, there is no parking along a yellow curb at any of the seven Norwin schools. This helps to maintain priority access for school buses or emergency vehicles.

For more information, please see Norwin School District Board Policy No. 707, Use of School Facilities, which is available at www.norwinsd.org under "School Board," "Policies and Procedures," and "Policies." Section 11 of the policy states that vehicles which create a safety hazard, obstruct traffic, or cause damage may be removed from school property at the expense of the owner of the vehicle. In addition, North Huntingdon Township Police Department can ticket cars parked in any No Parking zone or illegally parked in a handicapped space.
