Dear Students and Parents,

UNDER CONSTRUCTION: that is our current condition. Numerous projects have dominated our summer. Consider first, the complete renovation and expansion of our library to include innovative space for robotics and more. New phone systems and fire alarm systems required complete rewiring of our building. The parking lot gets a massive facelift. Typical of construction, delays have occurred; however, most work will be done by September. Completion of the new library and the Millburn Innovative Learning Lab is targeted for October.

In addition, we initiate a Common Lunch that brings new challenges in the form of seating, feeding, scheduling and monitoring students. **Keep in mind that a Common Lunch permits students time to do homework, study, seek extra help, conduct clubs, meet with counselors, collaborate or occasionally just reenergize.** We plan to mitigate inconveniences inherent to such a major change to lunch exasperated by construction.

- We will serve lunch both in the cafeteria and the new gym.
- We will utilize seating in both gyms – as well as the cafeteria.
- The Guidance suite, auditorium lobby and outside tables provide further seating during lunch.
- Students may eat in classrooms although, naturally, only with supervision.
- Extra administrators, teachers and Senior Ambassadors will help underclassman navigate hallways.
- Students may wish to bring lunch until confidence in the new lunch routines are fully established.
- Teachers will be understanding of student lateness due to blocked pathways or general unfamiliarity.
- Future adjustments may include pre-ordering lunch and utilizing more classrooms.
