Nurse Aide I Course Description

This course includes basic nursing skills required to provide safe, competent personal care for individuals.

Emphasis is placed on person centered care, the aging process, safety, care of the elderly during emergencies, legal and ethical issues, communication, infection prevention, vital signs, height and weight measurements, elimination, nutrition, basic restorative care, rehabilitation, dementia, mental health and end of life care.

Upon successful completion, students will be able to demonstrate knowledge and skills for the entry level practice of the nurse aide I. Students will be eligible to test for listing on the North Carolina Nurse Aide I Registry by successful completion of the National Nurse Aide Assessment Program administered by the North Carolina State testing agency.

The Nurse Aide I Training Course is being offered as a eight (8) week class.

Each class is limited to the first 20 eligible students.

Registration Guidelines:

1. The prospective student must be 16½ years of age on the first day of semester.
 2. Schedule the placement test by calling the Student Enrichment Center at (828) 659-0418 and meeting the minimum required score.
 3. To register for this class, contact the Department of Continuing Education at (828)-652-0675.
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Nurse Aide I Registration Requirements:

1. The prospective student must be 16^{1/2} years of age on the first day of semester
2. Meet the minimum required placement test score or ENG 111
3. Present a valid, non-expired, U.S. Government-Issued, signature bearing, Picture ID
4. Present a valid, non-laminated, signature-bearing Social Security Card matching their picture ID.
5. TB screening (two-Step), Hepatitis B immunizations and Flu shot. (As directed by clinical agencies)
