Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

Our number one priority has been, and always will be, offering a superior academic, spiritual, and holistic education to our students that respects and reflects the investment you make to provide a Catholic education for your child. Our leading edge curricula and innovative teaching strategies support students in striving to perform above the national percentile in standardized tests. At Bonner & Prendie, college acceptance is above 93% and the Class of 2018 was awarded close to \$17 million in college scholarships. With that, the Class of 2018 students were accepted into many major colleges and universities across the country including Villanova, Drexel, Florida State, Cornell, Georgia Tech, and the Naval Academy, just to name a few.

Understanding that many sacrifices need to be made to afford a Catholic education, we strive to find ways to assist our families in making it affordable. Three years ago, we introduced the restructuring of fees to assist you in budgeting for your student's education at Bonner & Prendie Catholic High School. The intention of this restructuring of fees was to minimize the practice of charging payments throughout the year to participate in activities while increasing student involvement in clubs, athletics, and other programs. In doing so, we continue to see an increase in attendance at school events and participation on sports teams, clubs and other activities. This does not only increase student engagement on our campus which contributes to retention; but has also proven to make our students more marketable to the colleges and universities they seek to attend after graduating from Bonner & Prendie.

In addition, thanks to many generous alumni and benefactors, as well as BLOCS, there are a number of opportunities to apply for scholarships and financial aid to assist with the tuition. If you have not already applied for financial aid, it is still not too late, however priority is always given to families who have a completed application on file in FACTS by March 15, 2019. Anyone receiving financial aid for the 2018-2019 year will need to re-apply for the 2019-2020 academic year. Please visit the [financial aid](#) page on the website for more information. We never take for granted the investment that you make in your student(s) and we have worked hard to minimize the increase to tuition each year. With that, we will only be raising the school fee \$50. This is the first increase in four years. In addition, we were able to make some reductions in expenses within our budget to only have to increase tuition by \$250 for the 2019-2020 academic year. **This will bring the *total* cost of attending Monsignor Bonner & Archbishop Prendergast Catholic High School for the 2019-2020 academic year to \$9350.** This minimal increase makes Bonner & Prendie one of the very best values in the Philadelphia area for an exceptional holistic Catholic high school education!

The first billing of the new school year will occur in June 2019 via FACTS. Again this year, there is an annual fee of \$42 for a monthly payment plan, \$10 for a semi-annual payment plan, and no


charge if you make your payment in full for the year. If you sign up for and make payments automatically each month, a \$120 discount will be applied to your account when your balance is paid.

Please note that the \$1550 school fee will be charged over an eleven (11) month period from June-April along with the base tuition payment. Unlike many other schools, again this year, included in the school fee, each student will be given a yearbook and a free Fall dance, the ability to participate in most athletics, as well as attend sporting events and our school shows for free! A full list of what is included in these fees is enclosed. As in the past, a portion of this fee may be recovered through the *optional* participation in the annual Chance Drive.

Similar to years past, we will be hosting a Town Hall meeting again this year to review the 2019-2020 tuition on Wednesday, February 27, 2019 at 7 PM in the Father Atkinson Center. Please feel free to join us to have any of your questions answered. Again, on behalf of our community, thank you for your commitment to Bonner & Prendie Catholic High School.

Included enclosed is a Tuition Payment Schedule 2019-2020 created by the Archdiocese of Philadelphia with the breakdown of payments for the 2019-2020 academic year and a Tuition Payment Schedule for 2019-2020 for International Students. In addition, a Bonner & Prendie addendum has been created and attached to show what the school fee covers.

TUITION PAYMENT SCHEDULE 2019-2020 *

Listed below are the tuition and school fee rates for the 2019-20 school year. The applicable tuition charges and the school fee will be billed over 11 months from June through April. Any grants or scholarships will be applied to those charges. Payments will be made directly to FACTS Tuition Management. There is a \$42 per family charge due in June 2019 if you would like a monthly plan, \$10 for a semi annual plan, and no charge if you pay in full with the first billing. Families that sign up and make all payments electronically will receive a \$120 credit at the end of the school year. The monthly late fee if tuition is not paid on time will be \$30. In FACTS Tuition you have the option to have your payment due the 1st of each month or the 15th of each month.

During the year, additional fees will appear on your monthly statement for registration, athletics and other school charges. There is an additional charge of \$1,850 for all students participating in the Drexel Program.

TUITION PAYMENT SCHEDULE FOR 2019-20 FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The Archdiocese of Philadelphia is certified by the Student and Exchange Visitor Program to enroll foreign students eligible for a F-1 Visa. Students must live with a blood relative or must come to us through an Archdiocesan approved agency. An approved agency is one that has demonstrated a commitment to the Standards for International Educational Travel as outlined by the Council on Standards for International Educational Travel (CSIET). Enrollment and tuition charges are subject to agreements between the agency(ies) and the school and Archdiocesan Office of Catholic Education.

A registration fee is due upon acceptance at the school. If enrolling for the Fall, the full tuition charges must be paid before the school year begins. If accepted during a school year, the full tuition and fee charges apply unless the student is enrolled in the second semester. If that is the case, one half of the tuition and fee charges are due.

During the year, additional fees will appear on your monthly statement for registration, athletics and other school charges.

If a student withdraws during the first semester of the school year, any tuition paid for the second semester will be refunded.

If a student withdraws after the second semester has begun, no refunds are issued.
