Laura earned her undergraduate degree in Nursing from ECU, her MA from the UK Patterson School in International Business and Diplomacy and her Master of Divinity degree from Lexington Theological Seminary. She has worked as a Chaplain at St. Joseph Hospital and the University of Kentucky. She currently serves as the Director of Mission for CHI Saint Joseph Health.

Laura worked as a student minister at VA medical Center, Hospice of the Bluegrass, Church of the Resurrection, Lexington Catholic High School and St. Peter Claver Church. Laura focused much of her research and teaching on how we can better Nurture Faith in the family.

Since she arrived in Lexington in 1979, Laura has taken significant civic leadership roles including past chair of the annual campaign for the United Way of the Bluegrass and past chair of the Salvation Army board of directors. She is a former chairwoman of the American Heart Association "Go Red For Women" luncheon. Laura was a founding board member of the Diocesan Newspaper "Crossroads." She began the Stephen's ministry program, a lay ministry program, at Christ the King Cathedral. Laura is a member of Holy Spirit Parish.
