On-Campus Parking -

Ala Napunani St. Parking Lot (Tennis Court side)

- Handicap parking available. Be prepared to show your HC placard, picture ID or HC card *(see below)*
- No left turn into parking lot from Ala Napunani St.

Ala Ilima St. Parking Lot (Fire Station side)

- Public parking on a space-available basis after 1:00 pm. No public parking during school hours.
- Gates open to public at 1:00 pm (after school). Once lot is full, the gates will close.
- Drop off is allowed for graduates, even after gates are closed.
- No left turn into parking lot from Ala Napunani St.

Handicap (HC) parking - Available in the Ala Napunani St. parking lot (tennis court side). Be prepared to show your placard, a picture ID, or the HC card upon entrance to the parking lot. Name on the placard must match the picture ID or HC Card. Drop off of handicapped individuals will still be allowed after all stalls are taken.

Additional Parking & Shuttle Service –

Additional parking is available at Aliamanu Elementary & Intermediate Schools.

Cost: \$2.00 per vehicle for parking

Shuttle Service time: 3:00 pm to 9:00 pm

Cost: Shuttle ride is FREE.

Pick up point: Aliamanu Elem/Intermediate parking lot

Drop off: Passengers will be dropped off on Likini St. near Moanalua High School. People needing shuttle service back to Aliamanu Elem/Intermediate should wait at the point of drop off. Shuttle service will run until 9:00 pm.

Stadium Info – Gates to stadium will open at 1:00 p.m. Shade structures, giant umbrellas, confetti, bullhorns, noisemakers, etc are NOT PERMITTED. Signs should not block the view of other guests. Guests are encouraged to wear flat-heeled shoes or wedges (no spiked-heels) in order to preserve the new rubberized track. Lei-giving will take place on the field, and off the track.

Caution – For your safety, please avoid any areas that are roped off.
