Riding the bus is a **PRIVILEGE**, not a right. Students who misbehave will be temporarily denied bus privileges. FPS reserves the right to remove any student whose behavior endangers other students. Repeated misconduct may result in permanent suspension of bus privileges.

Students on the bus must comply with the following policies and behavior guidelines:

- All riders will stay seated at all times and will not move from seat to seat
- Students who cause damage to seats will be responsible for repairs
- Aisles are to be kept clear of book bags, musical instruments, athletic bags, or other equipment
- Food, drink, and illegal substances are not permitted
- Students are not to be excessively loud
- Profanity of any sort will not be tolerated
- Students are not to yell at pedestrians or other vehicles or throw objects from the bus
- All electronic devices **MUST** be turned off

Parents or students who have concerns about behavior or safety should contact the school principal immediately. Parents of students reported for misconduct on the bus will be contacted by administration.
