Brownsboro ISD offers a full-day Pre-K and HeadStart program for qualifying students and is located at both Brownsboro and Chandler Elementary.

How do I apply?

Visit our website www.gobearsgo.net and click "Enroll" for an application and information on eligibility and enrollment details.

TO ENROLL YOUR CHILD YOU WILL NEED

Birth certificate for student

Social Security Card

Current Shot Record

Guardian's Driver's License

Proof of address

(electric bill, water bill, etc.)

Proof of income (W-2 forms or tax return)

Enrollment is not complete until all of the above is on file with the campus office.

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I know if my child qualifies to attend?

Please see the next page for a full list of items that can qualify your child for the program.

How old does my child have to be?

4 on or before September 1st

Is it free?

The program is free for children that qualify and if spots are not filled by a student who qualifies for Pre-k, your child may attend classes all day at the monthly rate of \$444.00.

Does my child qualify for Pre-K if they have a disability?

No, having a disability does not qualify a child for Pre-K; however they may qualify for HeadStart.

Is the program all day or half a day?


All day

Can my child ride the bus?

Yes, if they live in the District

Is there lunch provided?

Students that meet certain criteria through the Free and Reduced Lunch Program can receive free lunch or lunch at a reduced rate (\$\$\$). Last year all Pre-K and Head Start students were able to eat breakfast and lunch for free or at a reduced cost and we are hoping to provide that same benefit this year.



All students will be screened for Head Start, if they do not qualify for Head Start, they will be screened for Pre-K eligibility.



Does my child qualify for BISD's Pre-K/HeadStart program?

HeadStart/Pre-Kindergarten eligibility requirements are as followed: Must live within Brownsboro ISD. Child must be 4 years old on or before Sept. 1st

Families must meet **ONE** of the following criteria:

- Family income must fall within federal guidelines for free and reduced lunch program. Parents must complete free/reduced lunch form and show proof of income with the last year's income tax return and/or three current pay stubs.
- Limited English Proficiency
- Homeless (as defined by 42 U.S.C.S. Section, 11302)
- Child of an active duty member of the armed forces, mobilized Reservist or member of the Texas National Guard, including the child of a member who was hurt or killed on active duty. Parent/Guardian must present a Department of Defense identification (such as a DoD photo ID), a statement of service, or an official letter from a commander stating that he/she is on active duty or mobilized.
- Child was ever in conservatorship of CPS (must provide letter from CPS stating this)

All students will be screened for Head Start, if they do not qualify for Head Start, they will be screened for Pre-K eligibility.
