

# AIM Policies

Kennedy STEM Academy is thrilled to offer a variety of enriching experiences for students through our AIM Program. What is AIM? AIM stands for Active, Involved, Motivated. It is an after school program composed of fun and educational clubs.

Because they are proven to be successful, the program is popular and sought after by both parents and students. Each club has a limited number of participants allowed. Any student who does not make a desired club can add their name to the wait list.

## Please make note of these prior to registering your student for AIM.

A Strike System is strictly enforced. After 3 strikes, the student is no longer eligible to participate in the AIM session.

A student can receive a strike for poor behavior during the AIM program and for being picked up late.

The AIM program is designed to motivate students to attend school and try their best daily.

With this in mind, and as a part of our school plan, goal 6, a student can be removed from a club if any of the following occur at school within an AIM Session:

- Absent more than (4) school days
- Receive (2) Minor Discipline Referral Forms (green)
- Receive (1) Major Discipline Referral Form (yellow)

You will receive a note from the AIM coordinator informing you if your child is removed from an AIM club.
