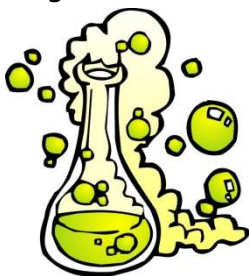

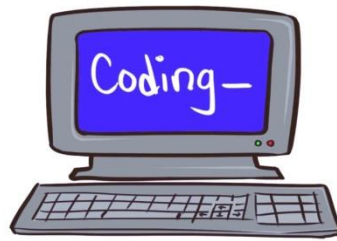

## (New) Guidelines, Policies and Procedures for 2018-19

### Policies and Procedures

Trimester #1 of Afternoon Adventures will take place Oct. 15, 2018 - Dec. 13, 2018. [Online registration](#) forms are due Wed., Oct. 3, 2018 at 8:00am. Registration for the drama club ONLY is due by Thurs., Sept. 6, 2018 at 8:00am.

Space in each club is limited. Clubs will be filled on a first-come-first-served basis and have a minimum and maximum capacity. Please note: Your child will only be registered for his or her designated club(s) once the online form has been completed and submitted. Fees will be billed and paid through TADS.

#### Refund Policy:

Prior to the first session: A full refund minus a \$10 processing fee will be returned.

After the first session: A prorated refund based on the values of the club minus a \$10 processing fee will be returned.

After the second session and beyond: You can opt to switch your child to another club (pending availability and permission from the instructor up until the 3<sup>rd</sup> club session), but no refunds will be returned.

No refunds will be issued in the event the school is closed or has an early dismissal for a weather related (i.e. snow, flood, etc.) or other emergency.

#### Financial Questions and Concerns:

All financial questions and concerns should be brought to the attention of [Shoshi Ryp](#), Acting Director of Finance. All outstanding balances must be paid before the beginning of the club semester. In the event that a balance has not been paid by that time, you will not be permitted to register your child for any clubs during the following semester.

#### Carpool:

If a situation should arise where you would like your child to skip his or her club on a particular day, you must submit a carpool change. All carpool changes must be made in writing by 2pm by emailing [Rachel Frank](#). **Please be prompt when picking up your carpool. Students will be dismissed to their carpools at 4:20pm. If you are more than 10 minutes late all children in your carpool will be sent to aftercare. You will be billed at a rate of \$10/child in your carpool/hour to**

**your TADS account. Room 21A is the aftercare room for PK and K and Room 12 is the aftercare room for 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade. Upon your arrival to BPY, please proceed to the aftercare room(s) to pick up your child/carpool.**

#### Instructor Absence:

In the event an instructor is absent on the day of his or her assigned club every effort will be made to find a suitable substitute. A suitable substitute is an individual who can facilitate the club in a manner similar to the usual instructor. It can be especially difficult to find suitable substitutes, especially for the more complex clubs. In the event a suitable substitute cannot be identified the club will be cancelled for the day. Parents will be notified as soon as possible and will have the option of sending their child to aftercare (at no additional cost) or picking up their child at his or her usual dismissal time. Mon., Wed. and Thur. clubs this trimester have a makeup day built into the calendar (Dec. 17, 19 and 20). Unfortunately, this accommodation could not be made for Tuesday club sessions.

#### Lack of Club Interest:

If there is not enough interest in a particular club (as determined by the enrollment requirements) the club will be cancelled. The option of registering your child for another club (pending availability) or receiving a refund will be afforded to you.
