- Provide a time and place for studying and reading at home

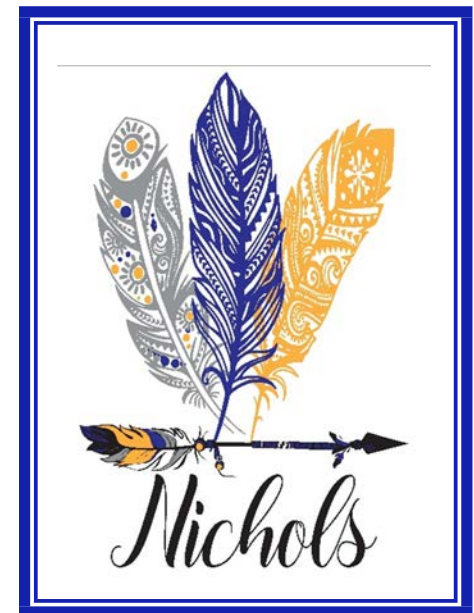
