Patrick Henry Middle School Culmination Requirements

To be eligible to culminate, students must meet all LAUSD and Patrick Henry culmination requirements. Students must earn a total of 50 credits during their 8th grade year to be eligible for a Certificate of Culmination. LAUSD's culmination requirements can be found at www.lausd.net.

Patrick Henry 8th Grade Culmination Requirements:

Detailed academic requirements for the class of 2019 will be published once approved by LAUSD.

Work Habits and Cooperation

- A maximum of 3 "U's"
- No more than 1 "U" in Cooperation for the final report card of the 8th grade year.

Student Citizenship

Referrals to the Dean's Office and excessive dress code violations may lead a student to lose the privilege of participating in 8th grade activities and/or culmination.

Appeal Process

You have the right to an appeal for an opportunity to participate in culmination. All appeals will be reviewed by a committee.

Attendance Policy

- No more than 10 absences for the entire year excluding a major illness or extenuating circumstance.
- A maximum of 10 tardies per semester.

Financial Obligation

No outstanding fees. Including: textbooks, cafeteria, student store, and library
