### Pre-K Registration Required Documentation

Parents should bring the following documents with them to register their child for PreK. **The registration process can not be completed without this information.**

1. Birth Certificate
2. Social Security Card
3. Medicaid Card (if applicable)
4. Immunization Record (from Health Department)
5. Proof of Residency (to include one of the following items):
  - A. Utility Bill(s) with service address or
  - B. Lease/Rental Agreement
6. Guardianship documents (if not the parent)
7. Parent / Guardian Driver's License or Identification



### Pre-K Registration Information

Pre-kindergarten students will need to register at the Hampton School District One Central Office located at 372 Pine Street East, Varnville, SC, on **April 26** or **May 10, 2019**, from 9:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. or **May 16, 2019** from 3:00 p.m. - 6:30 p.m. Failure to register your child may result in your child being put on a waiting list.

Hampton District One offers the Child Early Reading Development and Education Program (CERDEP all day program). **To be eligible, children must qualify based on income or be Medicaid eligible. However, there may be additional spaces to serve students who do not qualify with Medicaid. After the screening, children who can be served in the program will be notified.**

**This district child development education program offers: 1) small classes (low 10:1 pupil-teacher ratio, 2) specially trained teachers and assistants, 3) 6 ½ hour school day (free), 4) convenient 180 day school year, and 5) parenting support.**
