School Safety - Entry Buzzers will be Installed in all Schools

All schools will be getting entry buzzers for the front doors in the near future. This is an initiative by the Hampton One Board of Trustees to make schools safer. Persons coming to the schools will find the front doors locked. Once the security has been activated, individuals will have to push a button on the wall to notify the school receptionist. The receptionist will have a camera, a microphone and a door release button. After seeing and talking with the person outside the door, the receptionist will release the door lock to let the visitor into the school.

Wade Hampton Gym Renovation Project

The Hampton One Board of Trustees is in the process of addressing athletic facility needs. The Board approved the installation of side goals in the **Wade Hampton** gymnasium at the November 26, 2017, school board meeting. This will complete the renovation of the gym which included re-finishing the floor, painting the gym, replacing the banners, installing new curtains, and replacing the bleachers.
