NOTICE OF PROPOSED ADOPTION OF A SCHOOL FACILITIES NEEDS ANALYSIS AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ALTERNATIVE SECTION 65995.5 and 65995.7 FACILITY FEE (LEVEL II and/or LEVEL III FEE)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Governing Board of the Central Unified School District will consider input from the public on the proposed adoption of a School Facilities Needs Analysis (“SFNA”) for the District and the establishment of an increased “Alternative Section 65995.5 and 65995.7 School Facility Fee” (“Level II and/or Level III Fee”) on new residential developments. The adoption of the SFNA and the establishment of the Level II and/or Level III Fee are necessary to fund the construction of school facilities necessary to maintain current levels of educational services in the District and to accommodate growth due to development.
