MISSION BASILICA SAN DIEGO DE ALCALA

Mission Basilica San Diego de Alcalá was the first Franciscan mission in [The Californias](#), a province of New Spain. Located in present-day San Diego, California, it was founded on July 16, 1769, by Spanish friar [Junípero Serra](#) in an area long inhabited by the Kumeyaay people. The mission and the surrounding area were named for the Catholic [Didacus of Alcalá](#), a Spaniard more commonly known as *San Diego*. Today the Mission, which was founded in 1769, serves as an active parish church and cultural center for people of all faiths who are welcome to visit and relive the grandeur and excitement of more than two centuries of California history and tradition.
