Hot Lunch

The HASA Hot Lunch Committee organizes volunteers to serve lunch for the school. Lunches are ordered from local restaurants. Any parent who has ever served a meal can do this. Working parents can come by during their lunch break.

Hospitality

The Hospitality Chair organizes volunteers to bring goodies to HASA meetings and other social events throughout the year. There are approximately 15 events; some have refreshments, others require ordering flowers or a gift.

Seafood Festival

This event is one of our biggest fundraisers of the year. The Seafood Festival Committee directs volunteers to prepare foods and to set up the booth before the Festival, and organizes a schedule for working the booth Friday, Saturday, or Sunday for a 4-hour shift during the Festival.

Silent Auction

The Silent Auction Committee organizes auction donations, books a venue, sends out invitations, etc. This is the most exciting event of the year and our other big annual fundraiser. Donations are solicited from businesses and school families.

Used Uniforms

The Used Uniform Committee collects and organizes used (but in good condition) uniforms donated to the school for resale to other students. This raises money for HASA, and allows parents to buy uniforms at a much lower price than new ones.

Curriculum Enrichment

The Curriculum Enrichment Committee finds and schedules various groups or speakers to enrich our students' education with science, local history, or cultural arts events throughout the current school year.

Yearbook

The Yearbook Committee designs the yearbook, and keeps track of book and ad sales. Our yearbook is hardbound and full color from Jostens and is an excellent keepsake. Student Recognition Ads and Business Ads help support our yearbook fund.
