## 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade Girls Dress Code

### 2018-2019

- **Uniform Pleated Skirt**
  - St. Mary School plaid must be purchased from Connie's, School Blues or School Belles
  - Option of small pleated or 2 pleated skirt
  - **MUST touch the top of the knee cap or longer when standing – front & back**
  - Skirt should not be rolled at the waist
  - "Biker" type shorts maybe worn under the skirt – shorts should not be visible
- **Uniform Polo Shirt**
  - Navy Blue or White St. Mary embroidered logo polo shirt\*\*
  - Shirt must be tucked in at all times
  - Must be purchased from Connie's, Schoolbelles or Lands' End
  - PLAIN white cami or t-shirt maybe be worn under polo shirt – highly recommended
- **Uniform Pants – Optional Attire**
  - Khaki twill – "Dockers" type uniform pants– must be purchased at Connie's Schoolbelles, School Blues, Lands' End, or must be Dockers or IZOD brand from the uniform section at local department stores.
  - Khaki twill uniform shorts
    - Shorts allowed from first day of school until September 30<sup>th</sup>; May 1<sup>st</sup> until the last day of school
  - Plain brown or black dress belt must be worn with pants
- **Uniform Shorts – Optional Attire**
  - Khaki twill – "Dockers" type uniform shorts– must be purchased at Connie's Schoolbelles, School Blues, Lands' End, or must be Dockers or IZOD brand from the uniform section at local department stores.
  - Shorts allowed through September 30 & May 1 until the last day of school
  - Plain brown or black dress belt must be worn with shorts
- **Uniform Sweater – Optional Attire**
  - Navy or Red cardigan or pull-over or vest
  - Must be purchased from Connie's, Lands' End, School Blues or School Belles
- **Uniform Crewneck Logo Sweatshirt – Optional Attire**
  - Navy embroidered St. Mary logo sweatshirt
  - Must be purchased from Connie's, Schoolbelles or Lands' End
  - Polo uniform shirts must be worn underneath with collar showing
  - St. Mary athletic attire may not be worn

- **Socks or Tights**

- Plain Navy or white knee socks or tights must be worn with skirt
- Plain White or Khaki/tan anklets may be worn with uniform shorts only
- The following types of socks are not permitted:
  - Golf, footies, “no-show,” or sport socks
  - Logos, ruffles, bows, color or lace on the socks
  - Leggings and stretch pants
  - Tights without feet

- **Shoes - Further details on our website under recommended shoes**

- Sturdy black, or brown dress shoes
  - Plain black Mary Jane shoes – see website for recommended options
  - Sperry Boat Shoes – see website for specific shoe type & colors
- The following types of shoes are not permitted:
  - No two-toned, patent leather, velvet dress shoes, ankle boots, Crocs, flashing lights or open toe/open back shoes or Heelys
  - No shoes with colored stitching
  - Heels should be under an inch for safety reasons.
  - No athletic shoes of any style
  - No Saddle Shoes
  - NO Ballet Flats

- **Hair Styles For Girls**

- **No hair coloring or highlighting of any kind**
- No high “messy” buns
- No hair styles with beads, feathers, ribbons or other decorative materials
- Hair accessories:
  - Headbands, hair ties & bows: Uniform Plaid, Red, Navy Blue, White, Hunter Green or Black Only – **no decorations** attached to headbands
  - No pre-wrap headbands

- **Jewelry**

- **The following are allowed:**
  - Wristwatch - without sounds
  - Religious lapel pin
  - Small silver or gold or religious medallion necklaces are allowed
  - Small silver or gold religious cross or Crucifix necklaces and earrings are allowed
  - Earrings
    - Silver or gold **small** hoop earrings or stud earrings ONLY
    - Earrings must be worn only in earlobes.
    - Only one earring per ear

## Girls 6<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup> Continued

- **Jewelry not permitted at any time**
  - Rings or bracelets of any kind
  - Colored earrings
  - Titanium sport necklaces
  - Hair Ties
  - Other jewelry: Discretion of the administration
  
- **Nails**
  - Clear nail polish only
  - Fake nails are not permitted
  
- **Make-up**
  - Make-up of any kind is not permitted during school or at any school function. This includes the following occasions where students “dress-up” for special events throughout the year:
    - School dances
    - Confirmation
    - May Crowning
    - National Junior Honor Society Induction
    - Graduation
    - All other “dress-up” occasions
  
- **Tattoos or body piercings** of any kind are not permitted

**Administrative discretion will be used when necessary in the implementation and interpretation of this dress code. Three uniform notices will result in after school detention.**
