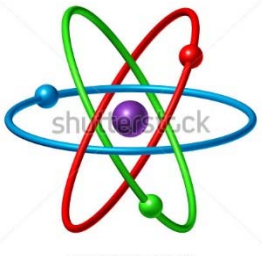

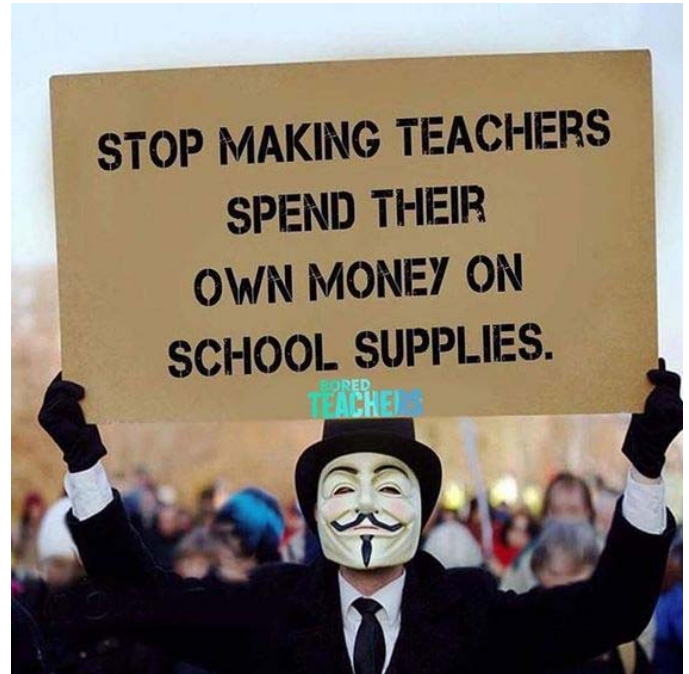

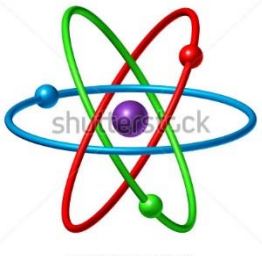

*Students being picked up by an after-school program along with multiple students must be signed out in the office.

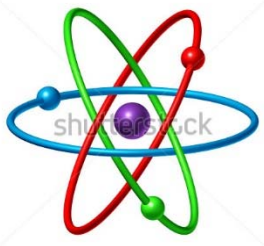
* Next Tuesday, August 28th, is **BACK TO SCHOOL NIGHT**, from 5-6pm.

*Thank you to PTO parents who volunteered to put First day of school packets together and for providing



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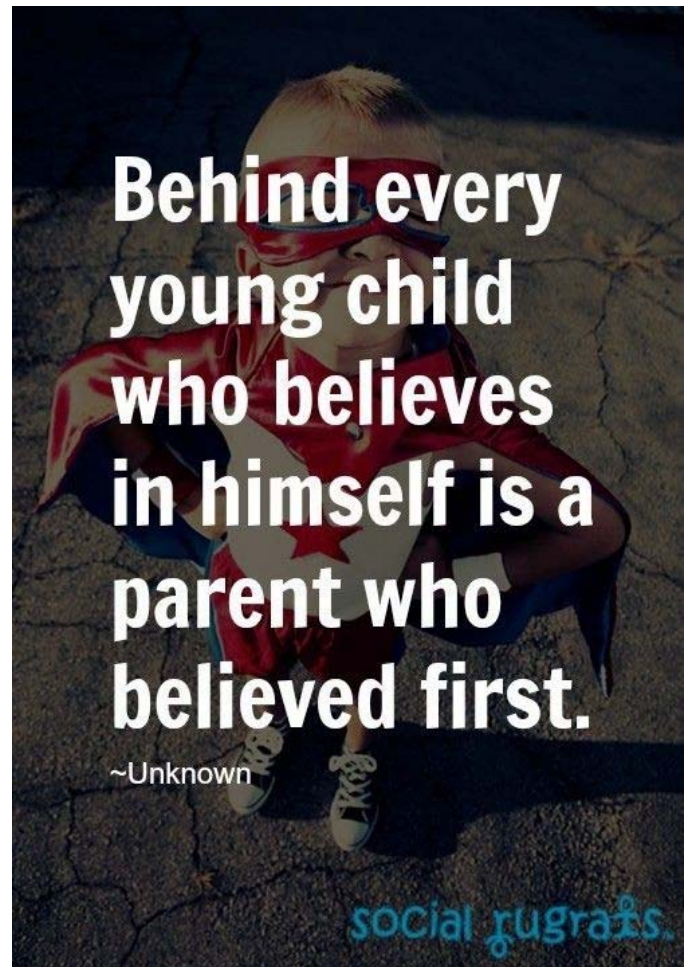
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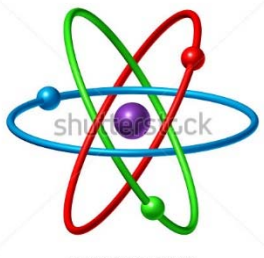
