About Us: The ACL D Tillotson School was founded in 1972 by a not-for profit corporation, The Association for Children and Adults with Learning Disabilities, Incorporated. Located in the South Hills area of Pittsburgh, the ACL D Tillotson School serves students ages 5 to 21 and school districts throughout a seven-county region. The school is licensed by the Pennsylvania State Board of Private Academic Schools and is approved by the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) and the Bureau of Special Education (BSE) to provide support and services to students with disabilities above and beyond those available in traditional classrooms. With highly specialized and individualized programs, students with complex learning disabilities and autism spectrum disorders are met with success.

The **Reading Clinic** supports students in need of intensive, high frequency reading interventions, delivered with direct, explicit instruction on a 1-to-1 basis or in small groups.



The **Specialized Learning Support Program** supports students with neurological impairments and moderate to severe learning disabilities in need of direct, explicit, and multisensory instruction with research-based methodologies.



The **Autism Support Program** supports students with autism who are in need of highly structured, research-based programming in order to gain optimal access to learning. Assistive technology supports an adapted curriculum, which is aligned with the Pennsylvania Core Standards. Individual and small group instruction, sensory integration support, and executive functioning support are also available to students enrolled in this program.
