Student **must** be 15 years of age by May 1, 2019

- Registration** Students may register for Summer School Driver Education at their home school or at the District office located at 10701 South Kilpatrick Avenue, Oak Lawn, until **Friday, April 19**.*
- Term** Classes will run every Monday through Thursday, June 3 to June 27. Classroom sessions will meet from 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. Behind-the-wheel schedules will be provided on the first day of class. Behind-the-wheel instruction may be held before classroom, after classroom, Fridays or Saturdays. The first day of pupil attendance is Monday, June 3. The last day of pupil attendance for the classroom portion is scheduled for Thursday, June 27, with Friday, June 28 designated as a possible make-up day.

- Tuition** The tuition for Driver Education is \$220. Checks or money orders must be made payable to **Community High School District 218**. No tuition waivers will be accepted for summer school driving. Registration is not complete without tuition payment.
- Transportation** Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from their campus building. In some cases, students may be allowed to take the bus to and from class but it is dependent on their driving schedule.
- Discipline** All rules and procedures in the 2018-2019 *Discipline Handbook* apply to summer school, along with the Summer School Rules and Regulations.

****Enrollment in the class will be limited due to the number of available cars and instructors. Parents/guardians will be notified whether their student has been accepted into the class by Monday, April 29, 2019. If your student is accepted into class, he/she must attend the "Testing for Permits" day.***
