On November 20, 2018, The Center for Disease Control and Prevention issued a broad scale public health notice, which can be found [here](#), indicating that all types of romaine lettuce could potentially be contaminated with E. coli O157:H7. The CDC and public health and regulatory officials are investigating outbreaks in 11 states.

There is no indication that any Taylor Farms products were a source. Taylor Farms has not initiated any form of product recall. To date, Taylor Farms has not been contacted by any federal agencies regarding this matter.

Consumer health and wellbeing is our highest priority. We continuously work to deliver the safest, freshest and highest quality produce and fresh food to promote the health and wellbeing of our customers. We implement cutting edge food safety processes and solutions, such as SmartWash, and invest in our people to ensure they are properly trained.
