Registration Information

- Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis per the date this form is received.
- Summer school is a self-funded program supported by student tuition.
- Classes may be eliminated if the number of students enrolled does not meet the minimum needed to fund a teacher.
- Instructor led courses are limited to 30 students.
- All Acellus courses, with the exception of Health, are limited to **credit recovery only**.
- Instructor led US History, World History and PE may be used for advancement only.
- No student is able to receive more than a total of one full credit for the successful completion of summer school in instructor led classes.
- For instructor led classes, a maximum of two (2) absences are allowed. After that, there will be no credit.
- Breakfast and lunch are available if needed for all students.
 - Breakfast is from 7:30- 8:00 am
 - Lunch will be served at 12:15 at the conclusion of classes
- For Acellus classes for credit recovery, you must attend 3 out of the 5 days in a week.
- You **MUST** attend the first day of classes, Wednesday, June 5 unless prior arrangements have been made. If you do not, your spot will be given to a student on the waiting list
- Three (3) tardies to any class, including after break, will count as one (1) absence
- Student Discipline will be based on DOE Chapter 19 policies:
 - Any Class A or B offense will result in dismissal from summer school.
 - Any Class C or D 1st offense will result in parent contact and a warning. A second offense will result in dismissal from summer school.
