Academic Strategies

Academic Strategies is a course open by request or recommendation. It is intended for students diagnosed with Learning Disabilities or for students identified by their performance on the High School Placement Test.

Academic Strategies will be individualized to meet each student's academic needs.

The class works both as a whole group and within smaller groups. The purpose of the class is to help students form a system of organization, build study skills, and transition more smoothly to demands of High School. Goals of the class include effective communication with teachers, parents, and peers. Students will be able to set appropriate short and long term goals and practice self-advocacy in an academic environment.

Study Hall

This elective course is for seniors only and is a class period that is used for study time. No credit is given for Study Hall.
