- **Registration Ends on June 7, 2019.** A late registration fee of \$25 will be added to any enrollments after 6/7/19.
- Only register for the camps that you are certain you will attend. **No refunds will be issued without a medical doctor's note.**
- You will need the student's William S. Hart District student identification number (Student ID) in order to sign up. If you are brand-new to the Hart District, contact the Registrar's Office at Saugus High School to inquire about your student's ID number
