**Early Childhood Options  
2018-19**

**Full-Day Kindergarten (Begins Fall 2018)**

**(Eader, Hawes, Moffett, Perry, Peterson, Seacliff, and Smith Elementary Schools)**

- **For students who turn 5 on or before September 1**
- Class ends the same time as grades 1-3.
- Standards-based, academic program. Small group academic instruction in reading, writing, and math. Social studies and hands-on, inquiry-based science. Developmental activities in creative learning centers, arts, and physical education.

**Transitional Kindergarten (TK)/Preppy Kindergarten (Preppy K) –**

**(Perry Elementary School – Begins Fall 2018)**

- **TK is for students who turn 5 between September 2 and December 2.**
- The first year of a two-year kindergarten program.
- Students with TK eligible birthdates will be given priority registration.
- **Preppy K is for students whose 5<sup>th</sup> birthday falls between July 1 and September 1 who may need the gift of time before starting kindergarten.**
- A developmental program based on kindergarten standards-based academic program.
- A year of preparation for students to have optimal success in kindergarten the following year.

**Extended Kindergarten (Perry Elementary School – Begins February 11, 2019)**

- **For students who turn 5 years old by the first day of the Extended Kindergarten program**
- Offered the beginning of February. Priority registration will be given to students whose birthday falls between September 2 and February 4. Registration will take place online: <https://registration.hbcds.us> Online registration will open at 8am December 3, 2018 and will close at 3pm on December 14, 2018.
- A developmental program to prepare students for success in Kindergarten. Students learn social skills and study skills.

**Preschool Academy (Eader, Perry, and Peterson Elementary Schools)**

- An engaging learning environment designed for ambulatory and independently toilet trained 3 to 5 year olds to support the development of the “whole child”. Emergent curriculum aligned with the California Preschool Foundations and Frameworks and Common Core Standards that adapts to the interests of children, and is creative, child-centered, and encourages exploration in science, mathematics, art, music and literacy. Designed to flow directly into the HBCSD kindergarten curriculum.

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### State Preschool Program (Perry Elementary School)

- An engaging learning environment designed for ambulatory and independently toilet trained to support the development of the “whole child”. Child must be 3 or 4 years of age as of September 1 of the year they are enrolling.
- Emergent curriculum aligned with the California Preschool Foundations and Frameworks and Common Core Standards that adapts to the interests of children, and is creative, child-centered, and encourages exploration in science, mathematics, art, music and literacy.
- Designed to flow directly into the HBCSD kindergarten curriculum—allowing for an ease of transition to the elementary school program.
- Experienced, highly qualified and licensed Early Childhood Instructors (1 adult: 8 children ratio - includes 1 licensed Preschool Instructor, 2 Preschool Instructional Assistants); maximum 24 children).
- Free for income eligible families; children with IEP may exceed income requirements.
