

California Immunization Requirements

Starting July 1, 2019 Students Admitted at TK/K-12

Need:

- **Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTaP, DTP, Tdap, or Td) — 5 doses**
(4 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday. 3 doses OK if one was given on or after 7th birthday.)
For 7th-12th graders, at least 1 dose of pertussis-containing vaccine is required on or after 7th birthday.
- **Polio (OPV or IPV) — 4 doses**
(3 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday)
- **Hepatitis B — 3 doses**
(not required for 7th grade entry)
- **Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) — 2 doses**
(Both given on or after 1st birthday)
- **Varicella (Chickenpox) — 2 doses**

These immunization requirements also apply to students entering transitional kindergarten.

California schools are required to check immunization records for all new student admissions at TK/Kindergarten through 12th grade and all students advancing to 7th grade before entry. Parents must show their child's Immunization Record as proof of immunization. <https://www.shotsforschool.org/k-12/>

***Temporary Medical Exemptions will need to be renewed annually by a licensed California MD/DO (no other practitioner may write and exemption). This regulation change is in effect July 1, 2019.**

Children must meet one of these conditions for **conditional admission**:

Condition	Timeline
A. Children have received at least 1 dose in a series and the deadline for the next dose has not passed.	Remaining dose(s) due based on interval timing
B. A <u>valid</u> statement of Temporary Medical Exemption is submitted with immunization records for required shots not exempted.	Remaining dose(s) due at end of exemption
