

School Fees - per student

Basic School Supplies - The district will be purchasing basic school supplies for all students in grades K-7th. Your \$25 school fee will be used to cover the cost of these supplies. There will be some optional supplies parents may wish purchase and the supply list will be posted on the district's website and at local stores.

Blossom Gulch and Madison

School Fee: \$25.00 at registration

Swimming Fee: \$10.00 at time of swimming

Millicoma and Sunset Fees:

School Fee: \$25.00 at registration

Athletic Fee: Athletic fees at the middle school are \$50.00 per sport and are only for 7th grade students that participate in football, volleyball, basketball, track and 6th & 7th grade students that participate in cross country and wrestling. A physical is required.

Harding Learning Center Fees:

School Fee: \$10.00 at registration

Yearbook Fee: \$20.00 upon delivery

Marshfield High School Fees:

ASB Student Fee: \$20.00 required (non-refundable)

Band Fee: \$20.00 for students in band programs other than Marching Band

Book Deposit Fee: \$50.00 required for 8th graders, new students and returning students that have not previously paid the deposit. This is a one-time fee that is refundable after charges are cleared upon graduation or withdrawal.

Mahiscan Yearbook: Main Mahiscan \$60.00. Spring Book is \$20.00 (\$80.00 when you purchase both at Registration)

Marching Band Fee: \$60.00 uniform cleaning fee for students in Marching Band

MHS Planner Fee: \$5.00 required for all students

MHS Athletic User Fee: \$100 per sport for students grades 9-12.

\$50 per sport for middle school students including 8th grade

PSAT Test: \$15.00 - for Juniors only (optional)

Parking Fee: Main or Pirate parking, \$30.00. Harding parking, \$5.00.

Past Due Charges: Please pay at the Main Office.

PE Uniforms: \$20.00 (\$9 for shirts and \$11 for shorts if purchased separately and are required for all students in Physical Education classes)

Student Activity Fee: \$10.00 (optional) Includes validation sticker on student body card admitting to MHS home athletic events
