Those wishing to address items not on the agenda should do so during Community Participation.

When you bring a question or concern to the Board, it may not be possible to receive an immediate reply. Some matters will be referred to administration for investigation and could be rescheduled for a future Board meeting if policy action is needed. If this is the case, you will be notified of the meeting date. By law, the Board may not take action on an item not on the agenda.





San Lorenzo Valley schools depend upon the active involvement and support of citizens working with teachers, administrators, and Board members to provide quality education for San Lorenzo Valley students.

BOARD MEETINGS

Governing Board meetings are typically held twice a month on Wednesday evenings at 6:00 p.m. in the multi-purpose room at the District Office on the Quail Hollow campus located at 325 Marion Avenue, Ben Lomond (unless otherwise posted). Specific meeting dates for the current year are listed on the back of this brochure. Agendas of regularly scheduled meetings are posted at the District Office, on the District web page, and at each school site prior to the meeting date. Requests to have an address added to the mailing list to receive agendas can be made through the Superintendent's office.

All of the action of the Board takes places in public session and requires at least three affirmative votes.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

The meeting follows an established agenda. Board members receive the agenda a few days prior to the meeting so they can study the items and be ready to take action.

CALL TO ORDER

Three Board members must be present before official business can be conducted.

CLOSED SESSION

In accordance with California Law, the Board may meet in Closed Session to discuss personnel items, litigation, student disciplinary actions and collective bargaining negotiations. The public is excluded from this portion of the agenda, but may address the Board prior to Closed Session when Public Comments are called for.

Action taken in Closed Session, resulting from discussion in Closed Session, must be reported when the Board reconvenes in public session.

ORGANIZATIONAL UPDATES / SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Board members, the Superintendent, a representative from the Associated Student Body, the San Lorenzo Valley Teachers' Association and the Service Employees International Union share items of interest.

COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION

This is an opportunity for members of the audience to address items not on the agenda. You **are requested to submit a card** (located on the entry table) **prior to the discussion of the item you wish to speak to**; once an item has begun, cards will not be accepted for that item. For the record, please state your name.

PUBLIC COMMENT – COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION

The Board President will call for Public Comment for items that are listed on the agenda during this item.

REPORTS AND ACTION ITEMS

This portion of the agenda allows the Board to receive reports and requires the Board to take action on specific items prepared for its consideration. These items generally are in the categories of Instructional Services, Personnel or Business Services. Items generally are submitted for a First Reading and will return for approval as a Second Reading or on the Consent Agenda. However, an asterisk preceding a First Reading item requires action without a Second Reading.

CONSENT AGENDA

These items usually include personnel reports, purchase orders, service and consultant contracts, annual contract renewals and items that appeared for a First Reading at the previous meeting. This section of the agenda permits the Board to deal with all of these items in one motion. However, any Board member has the option of requesting that an individual item be pulled and considered separately.
