Special collections displayed throughout the year included:

INDIA: Display included a variety of everyday items, such as dishes, toys, and clothing along with a sampling of different Indian art forms and kites, cymbals, sitar wall hanging and jewelry.

ARCHITECTURE: Presentation on one of the oldest forms of human creativity. The need to find shelter has led to the creation of the most amazing structures. Miniature models of some of the most famous architectural landmarks from around the world included Paris, Tokyo, Japan and New York, along with templates and blueprints.

EASTERN WOODLANDS: Objects were representative of what the Eastern Woodland Indians would have used in their daily lives and included: Beads, Beaded Moccasins, Turtle Shell Rattle, Deertoe Dance Rattles, Roach Headdress, Corn Husk Doll, Rabbit Pelts, Gourds and Stone Tool Artifacts.
